



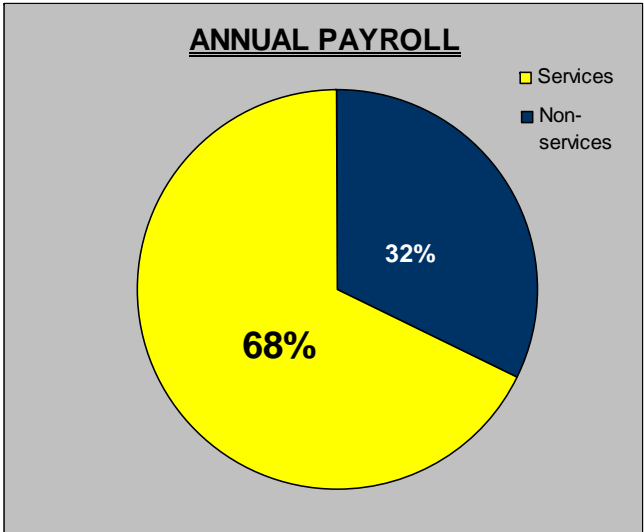
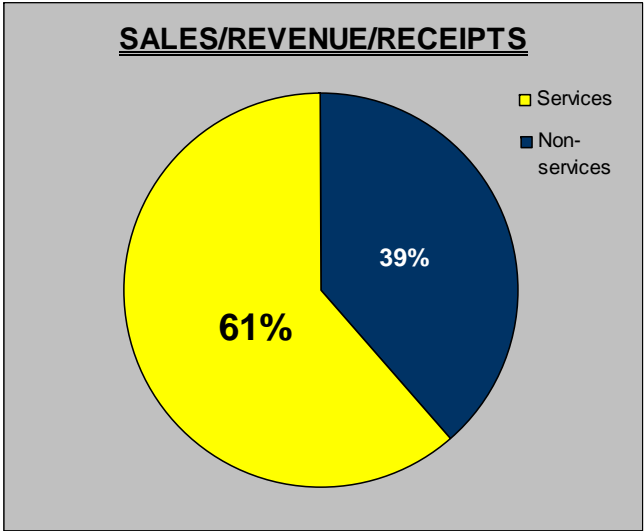

Services and the State of Alabama

The importance of the service sector to the state of Alabama is illustrated vividly by recently-released data from the US Bureau of the Census. Census data show that the services sector employs 73% of the Alabama workforce, in industries such as wholesale and retail trade, transportation & warehousing, finance & insurance, real estate, renting, & leasing, professional services, and many others. Services account for 68% of the state's \$44 billion payroll, and represent 61% of the \$219 billion in sales from the state's business establishments.
