



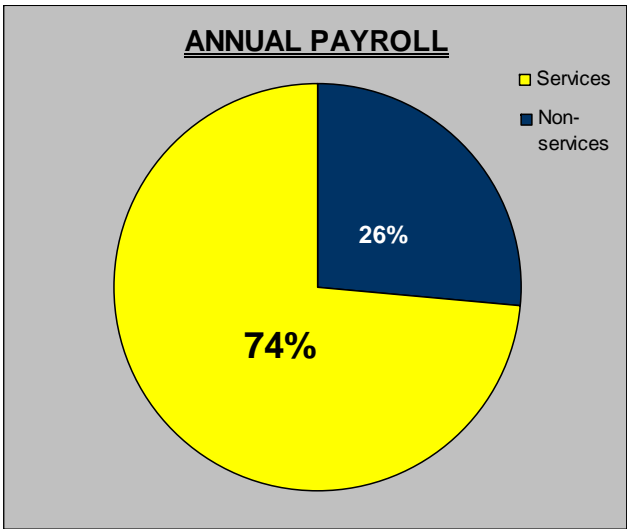
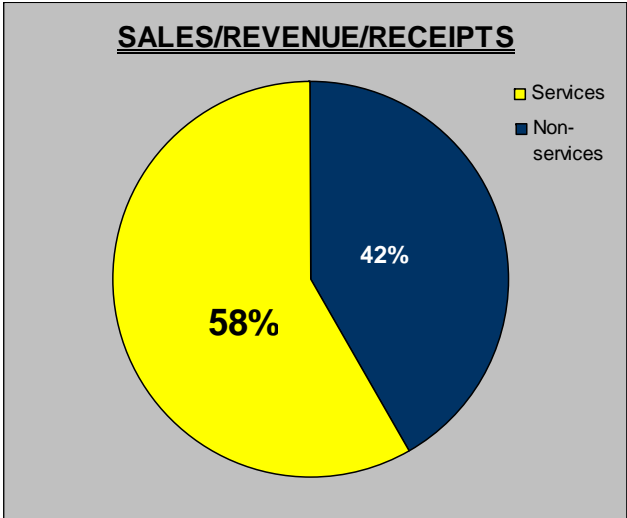

Services and the State of Alaska

The importance of the service sector to the state of Alaska is illustrated vividly by recently-released data from the US Bureau of the Census. Census data show that the services sector employs 80% of the Alaska workforce, in industries such as wholesale and retail trade, transportation & warehousing, finance & insurance, real estate, renting, & leasing, professional services, and many others. Services account for 74% of the state's \$8 billion payroll, and represent 58% of the \$40 billion in sales from the state's business establishments.
