

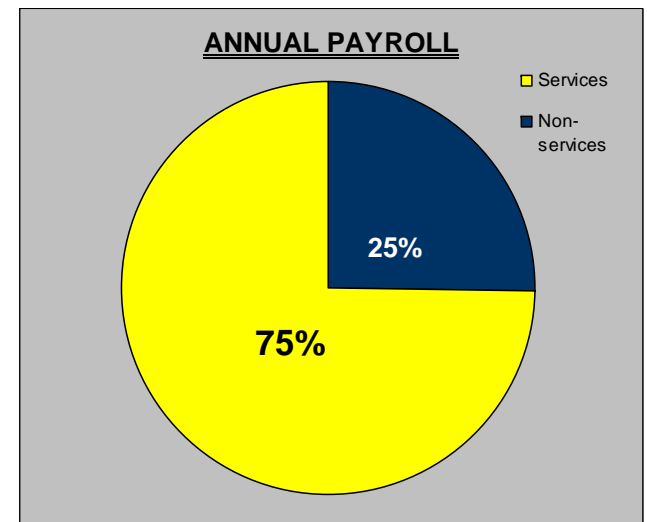
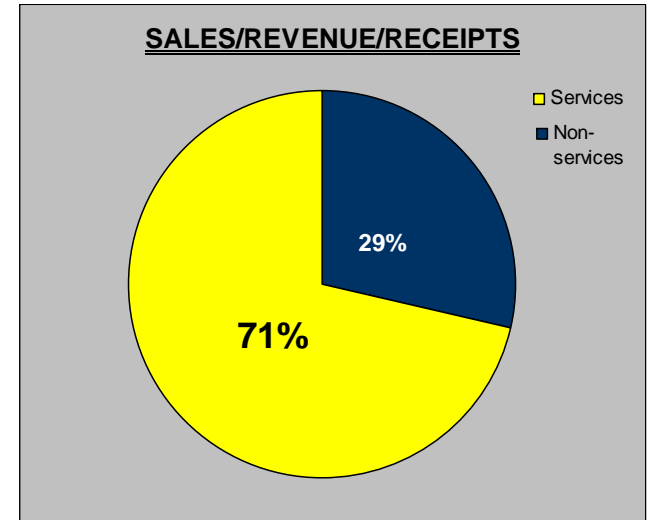


Coalition of Service Industries

Services and the State of Arizona

The importance of the service sector to the state of Arizona is illustrated vividly by recently-released data from the US Bureau of the Census. Census data show that the services sector employs 74% of the Arizona workforce, in industries such as wholesale and retail trade, transportation & warehousing, finance & insurance, real estate, renting, & leasing, professional services, and many others. Services account for 75% of the state's \$51 billion payroll, and represent 71% of the \$254 billion in sales from the state's business establishments.
