



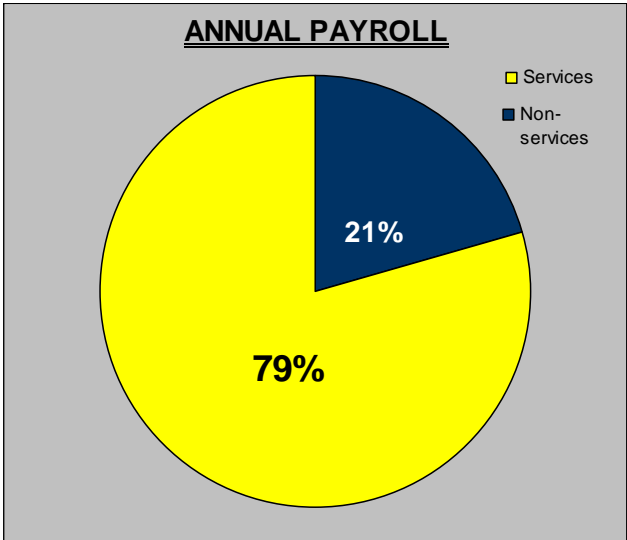
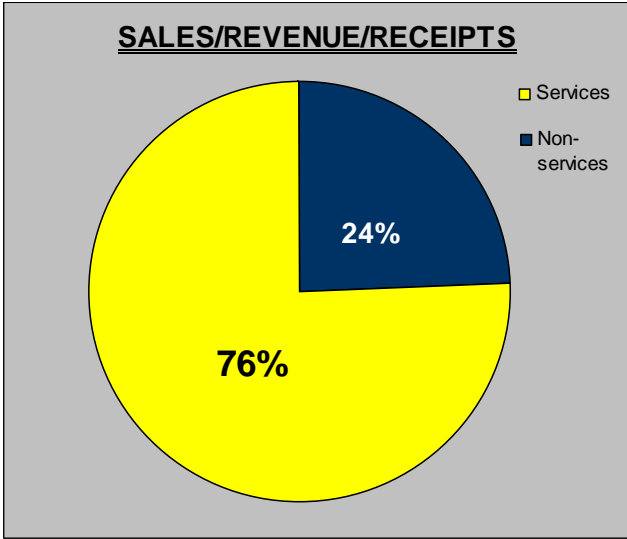
# Coalition of Service Industries

## Services and the State of Colorado

The importance of the service sector to the state of Colorado is illustrated vividly by recently-released data from the US Bureau of the Census. Census data show that the services sector employs 82% of the Colorado workforce, in industries such as wholesale and retail trade, transportation & warehousing, finance & insurance, real estate, renting, & leasing, professional services, and many others. Services account for 79% of the state's \$67 billion payroll, and represent 76% of the \$298 billion in sales from the state's business establishments.
