



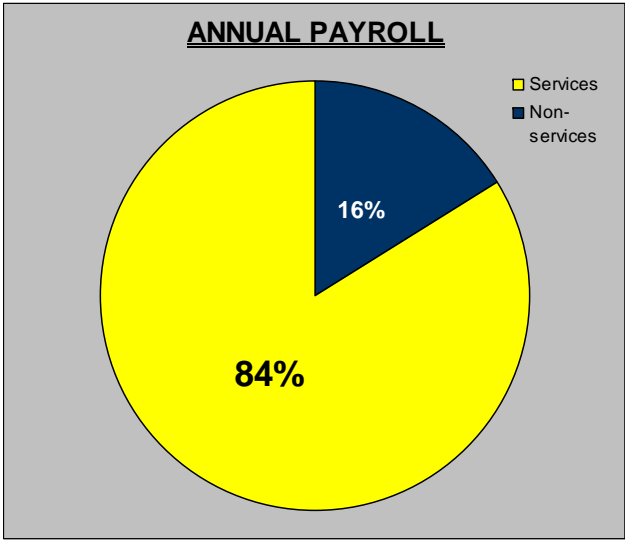
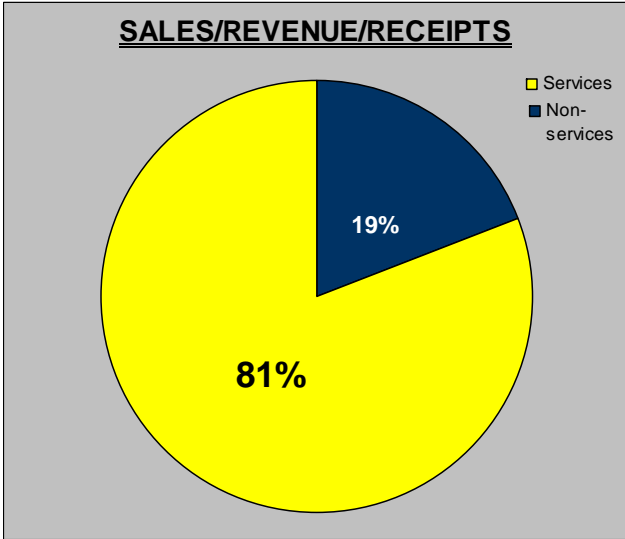
# Coalition of Service Industries

## Services and the State of Florida

The importance of the service sector to the state of Florida is illustrated vividly by recently-released data from the US Bureau of the Census. Census data show that the services sector employs 86% of the Florida workforce, in industries such as wholesale and retail trade, transportation & warehousing, finance & insurance, real estate, renting, & leasing, professional services, and many others. Services account for 84% of the state's \$182 billion payroll, and represent 81% of the \$833 billion in sales from the state's business establishments.
