



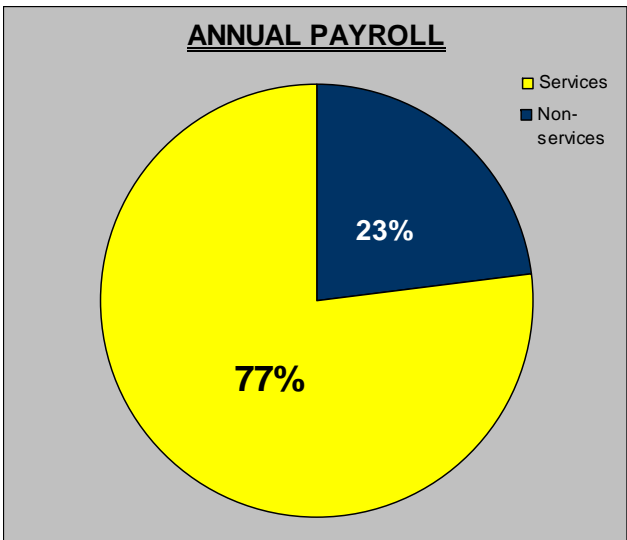
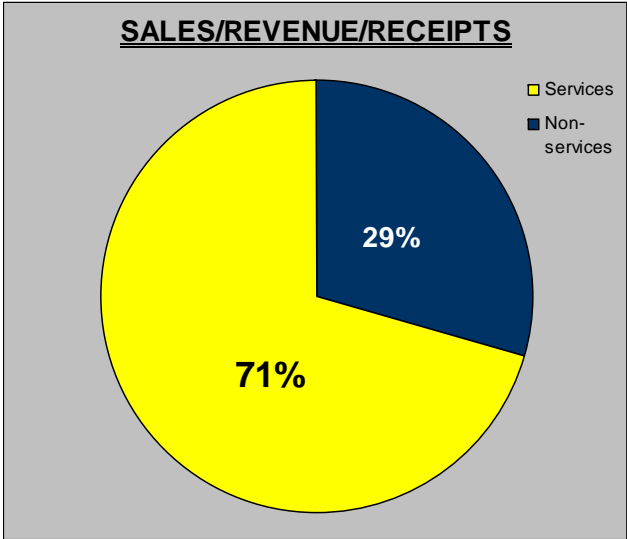

Services and the State of Georgia

The importance of the service sector to the state of Georgia is illustrated vividly by recently-released data from the US Bureau of the Census. Census data show that the services sector employs 78% of the Georgia workforce, in industries such as wholesale and retail trade, transportation & warehousing, finance & insurance, real estate, renting, & leasing, professional services, and many others. Services account for 77% of the state's \$106 billion payroll, and represent 71% of the \$577 billion in sales from the state's business establishments.
