



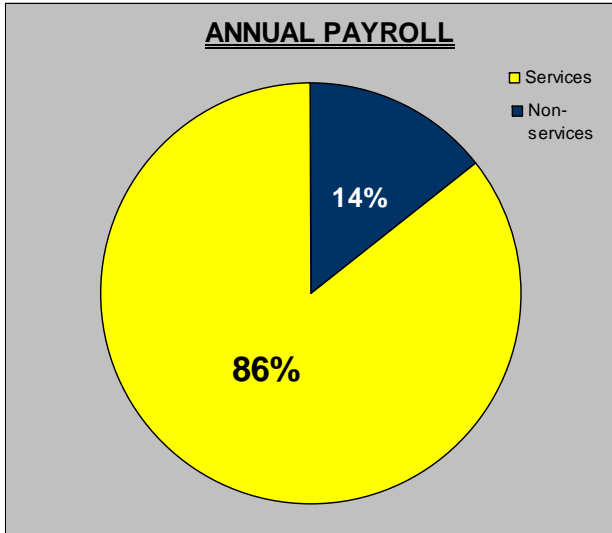
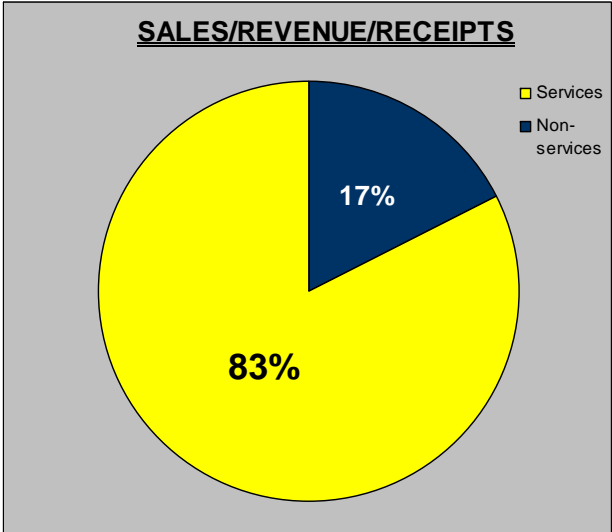

Services and the State of Hawaii

The importance of the service sector to the state of Hawaii is illustrated vividly by recently-released data from the US Bureau of the Census. Census data show that the services sector employs 90% of the Hawaii workforce, in industries such as wholesale and retail trade, transportation & warehousing, finance & insurance, real estate, renting, & leasing, professional services, and many others. Services account for 84% of the state's \$12 billion payroll, and represent 83% of the \$52 billion in sales from the state's business establishments.
