



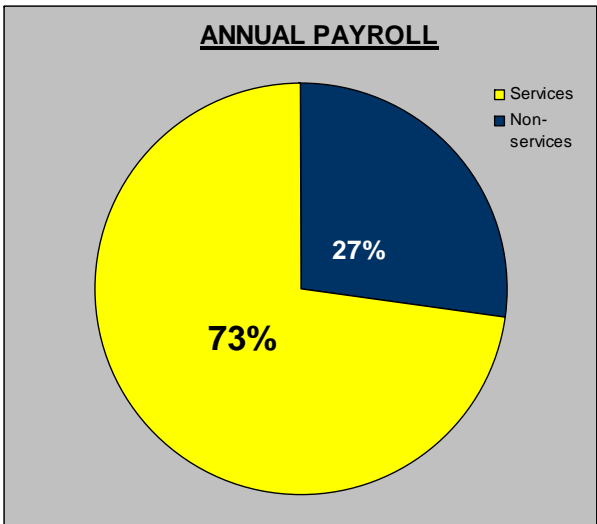
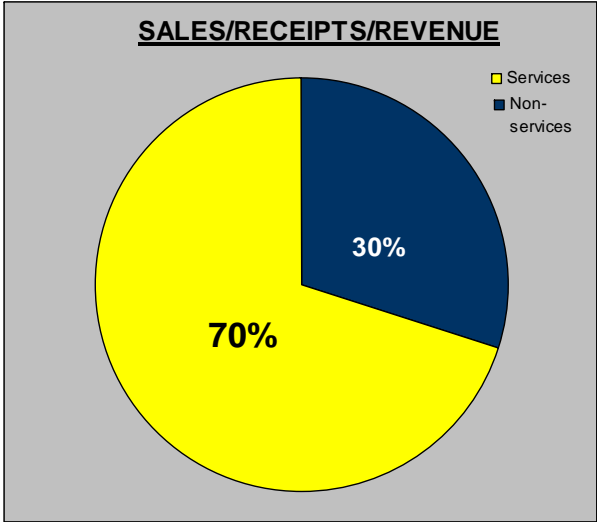
# Coalition of Service Industries

## Services and the State of Maine

The importance of the service sector to the state of Maine is illustrated vividly by recently-released data from the US Bureau of the Census. Census data show that the services sector employs 79% of the Maine workforce, in industries such as wholesale and retail trade, transportation & warehousing, finance & insurance, real estate, renting, & leasing, professional services, and many others. Services account for 73% of the state's \$14 billion payroll, and represent 70% of the \$60 billion in sales from the state's business establishments.
