



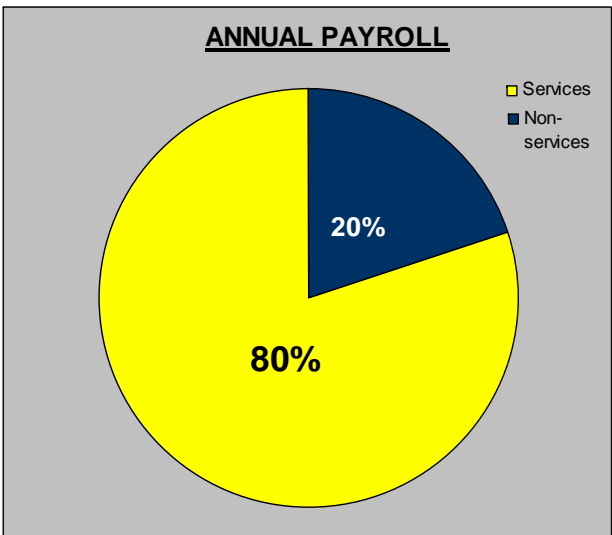
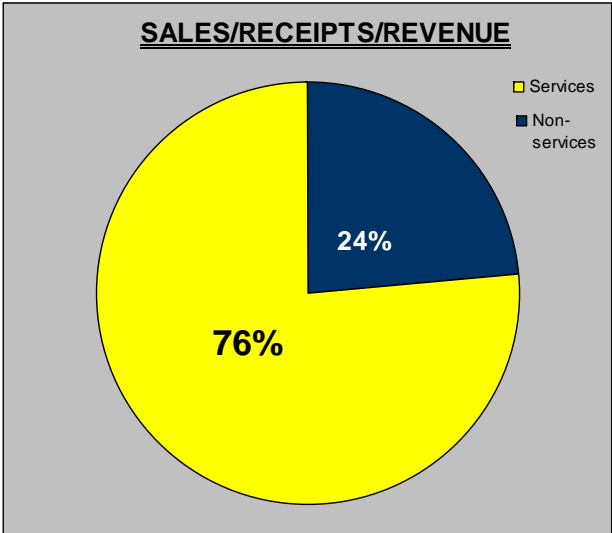
# Coalition of Service Industries

## Services and the State of Maryland

The importance of the service sector to the state of Maryland is illustrated vividly by recently-released data from the US Bureau of the Census. Census data show that the services sector employs 83% of the Maryland workforce, in industries such as wholesale and retail trade, transportation & warehousing, finance & insurance, real estate, renting, & leasing, professional services, and many others. Services account for 88% of the state's \$64 billion payroll, and represent 76% of the \$281 billion in sales from the state's business establishments.
