



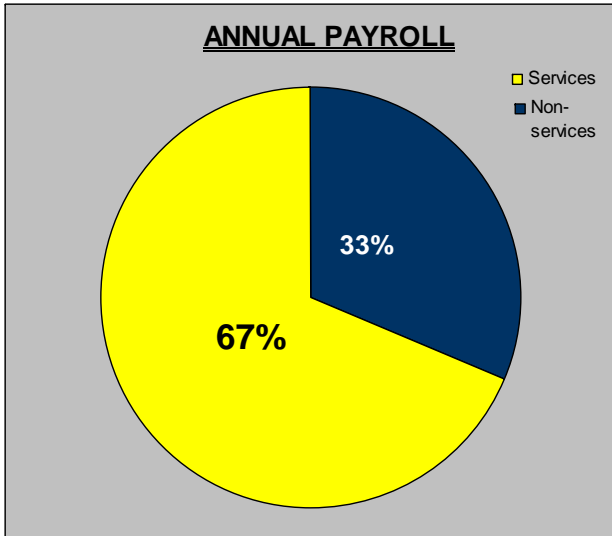
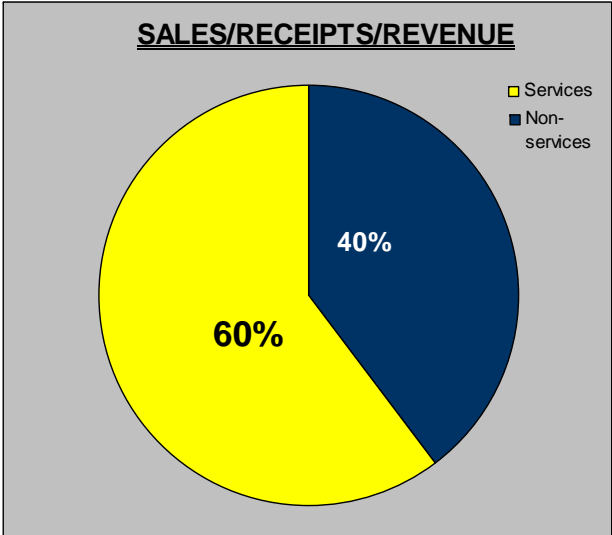
# Coalition of Service Industries

## Services and the State of Michigan

The importance of the service sector to the state of Michigan is illustrated vividly by recently-released data from the US Bureau of the Census. Census data show that the services sector employs 72% of the Michigan workforce, in industries such as wholesale and retail trade, transportation & warehousing, finance & insurance, real estate, renting, & leasing, professional services, and many others. Services account for 69% of the state's \$1334 billion payroll, and represent 60% of the \$654 billion in sales from the state's business establishments.
