



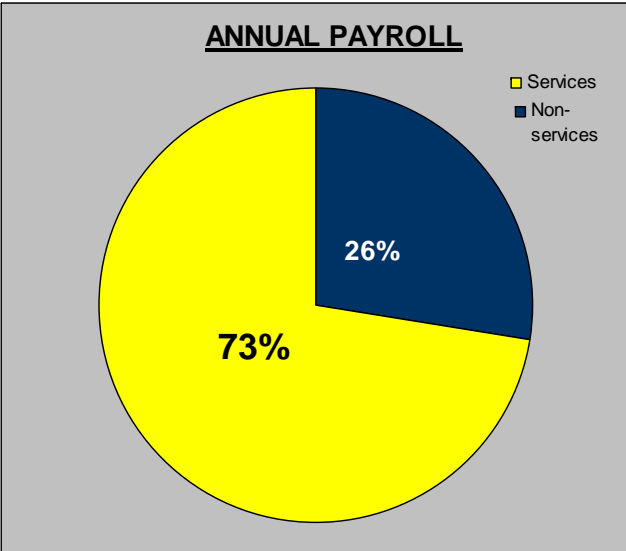
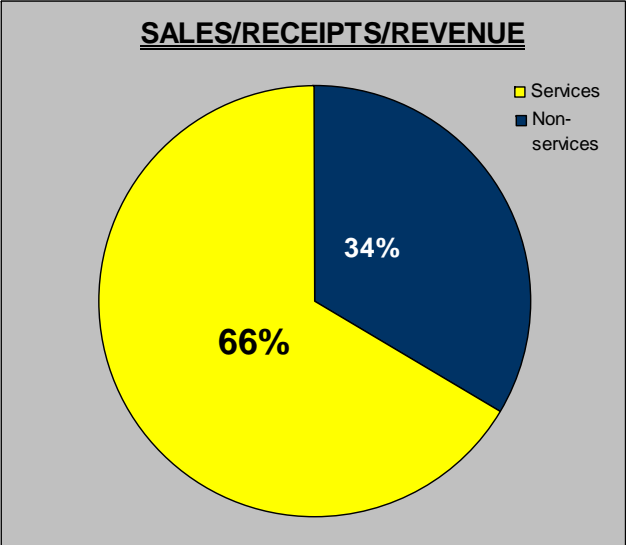

Services and the State of Missouri

The importance of the service sector to the state of Missouri is illustrated vividly by recently-released data from the US Bureau of the Census. Census data show that the services sector employs 78% of the Missouri workforce, in industries such as wholesale and retail trade, transportation & warehousing, finance & insurance, real estate, renting, & leasing, professional services, and many others. Services account for 73% of the state's \$72 billion payroll, and represent 66% of the \$357 billion in sales from the state's business establishments.
