

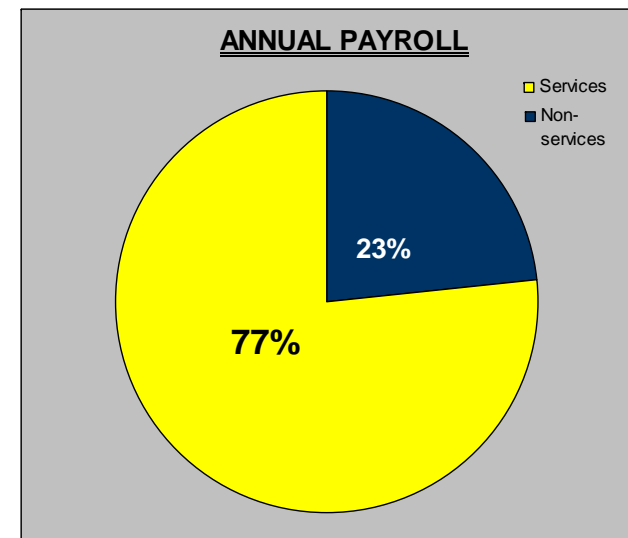
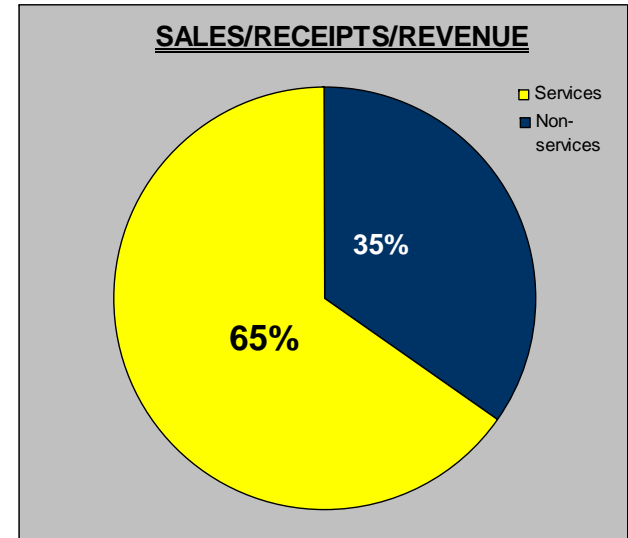


Coalition of Service Industries

Services and the State of Nebraska

The importance of the service sector to the state of Nebraska is illustrated vividly by recently-released data from the US Bureau of the Census. Census data show that the services sector employs 79% of the Nebraska workforce, in industries such as wholesale and retail trade, transportation & warehousing, finance & insurance, real estate, renting, & leasing, professional services, and many others. Services account for 77% of the state's \$21 billion payroll, and represent 65% of the \$108 billion in sales from the state's business establishments.
