



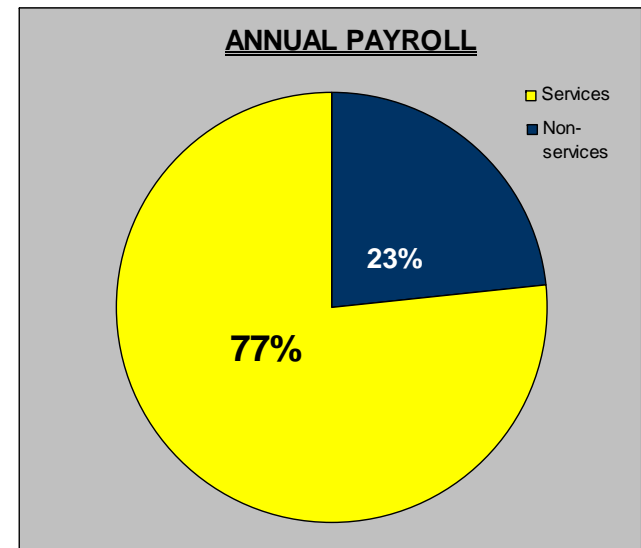
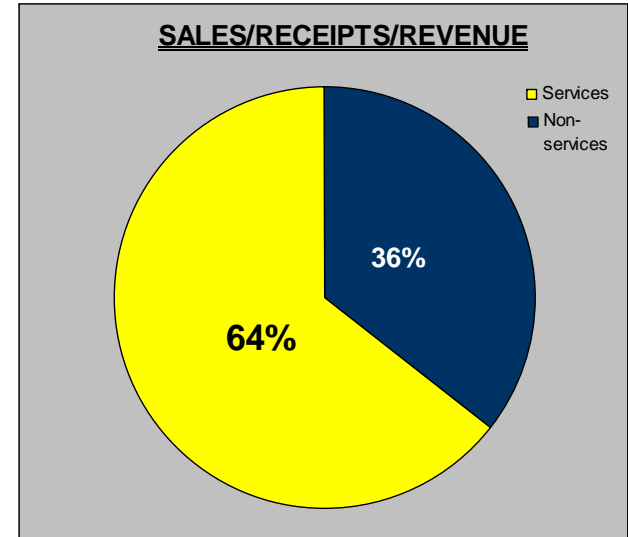

Services and the State of New Mexico

The importance of the service sector to the state of New Mexico is illustrated vividly by recently-released data from the US Bureau of the Census. Census data show that the services sector employees 82% of the New Mexico workforce, in industries such as wholesale and retail trade, transportation & warehousing, finance & insurance, real estate, renting, & leasing, professional services, and many others. Services account for 77% of the state's \$15 billion payroll, and represent 64% of the \$73 billion in sales from the state's business establishments.
