

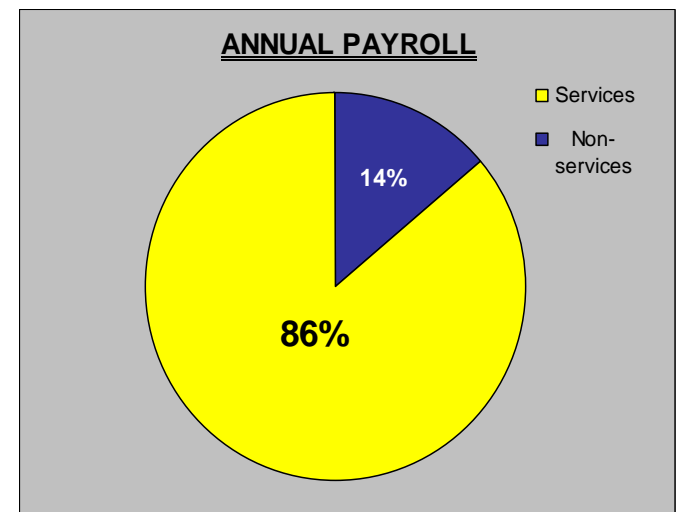
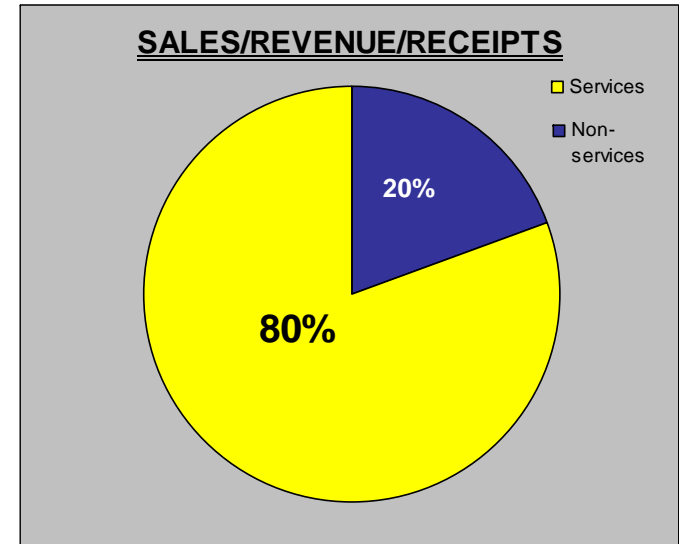


Coalition of Service Industries

Services and the State of New York

The importance of the service sector to the state of New York is illustrated vividly by recently-released data from the US Bureau of the Census. Census data show that the services sector employs 85% of the New York workforce, in industries such as wholesale and retail trade, transportation & warehousing, finance & insurance, real estate, renting, & leasing, professional services, and many others. Services account for 86% of the state's \$318 billion payroll, and represent 80% of the \$1.1 trillion in sales from the state's business establishments.
