



**Services and the State of Pennsylvania**

The importance of the service sector to the state of Pennsylvania is illustrated vividly by recently-released data from the US Bureau of the Census. Census data show that the services sector employs 75% of the Pennsylvania workforce, in industries such as wholesale and retail trade, transportation & warehousing, finance & insurance, real estate, renting, & leasing, professional services, and many others. Services account for 72% of the state's \$159 billion payroll, and represent 66% of the \$722 billion in sales from the state's business establishments.
