



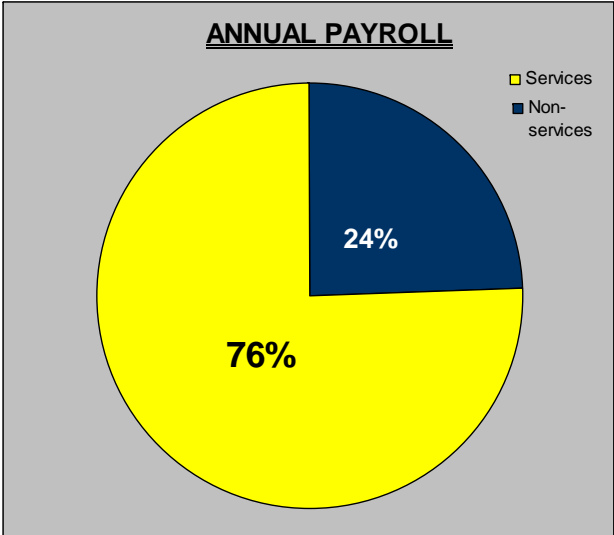
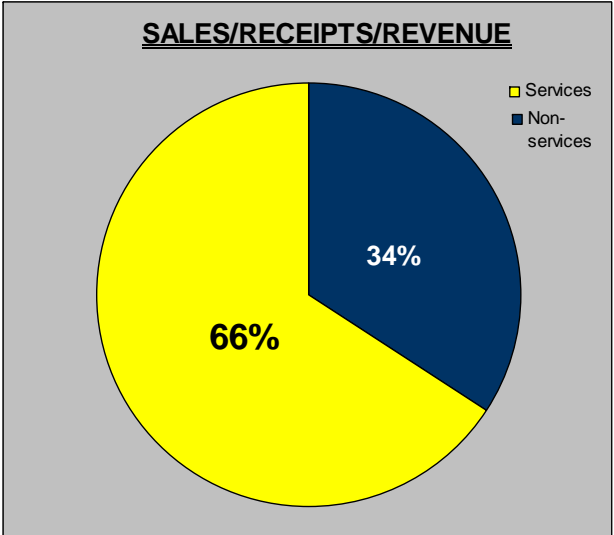

Services and the State of South Dakota

The importance of the service sector to the state of South Dakota is illustrated vividly by recently-released data from the US Bureau of the Census. Census data show that the services sector employs 77% of the South Dakota workforce, in industries such as wholesale and retail trade, transportation & warehousing, finance & insurance, real estate, renting, & leasing, professional services, and many others. Services account for 73% of the state's \$7 billion payroll, and represent 64% of the \$40 billion in sales from the state's business establishments.
