Services and the State of Texas

The importance of the service sector to the state of Texas is illustrated vividly by recently-released data from the US Bureau of the Census. Census data show that the services sector employs 76% of the Texas workforce, in industries such as wholesale and retail trade, transportation & warehousing, finance & insurance, real estate, renting, & leasing, professional services, and many others. Services account for 76% of the state's \$258 billion payroll, and represent 67% of the \$1.4 trillion in sales from the state's business establishments.
